Pro Swift 4 will feature elite Canadian players

in a carrom competition played over 2 months on a league basis. All players will play each other in this pilot project using basic rules to begin with, although more tweaks will be added in future competitions.

All matches in the tournament will be played over 2 games of 4 boards each. Player winning both games get 4 match points and if in case of a draw (both players winning a game apiece) then both of them receive 2 match points each.

Standard ICF rules of the game will be applied, such as, a maximum of 15 seconds per shot, game is of 25 points or 4 boards whichever comes first. In case of tie in game, then each player gets 1 point i.e. if the first game is tied and the second game is won by player A then player A gets 2 match points for the second game and 1 match point

for the first game, totaling 3 match points, whilst player B gets 1 match point from the 1st game. Game points will be used for ranking the players in case match points are equal.

Matches will be played over 11 sessions (refer schedule below). We expect to play 5 rounds on Sundays and 4 on Fridays. Players can opt to a minimum of 6 sessions of the 11 available if they wish to. Match schedules will be made accommodating players requests, hence, no further request for cancellations and changes will be entertained. Please note that players not reporting on time or not showing up, can expect a walk-over to the opponent. All players are also requested to referee games when available and schedules will be done accommodating their free time.

Cash prizes will be awarded to the top 8 players in the league.

All interested players are requested to submit their entries by the 5th of February 2017 along with an entry fee of \$50.
